Frequently Asked Questions

Stay up to date – <u>Frankston Events Facebook</u>

When is the Live and Local Event Series? The series of events will run across Saturday 20 and Sunday 21 March 2021.

Is the Live and Local Event Series replacing The Waterfront Festival?

Yes, the Live and Local Event Series will replace The Waterfront Festival. Due to the current COVID-19 restrictions, it was not possible to run an outdoor event on the scale of The Waterfront Festival.

Is there a fee to attend?

It is free to attend the Live and Local event series. There will be costs for any items you purchase, such as items from food vendors or market stalls and amusement rides.

Can I move between the different sites throughout the weekend?

Yes, you will be able to move around our event sites and other locations throughout the weekend. You will need to register via QR code to each location you enter, much like if you were going to a restaurant and then a movie.

Will there be food and drinks available?

There will be a range of food and beverage options at these events with different vendors at each site. A list of vendors will be available on the Discover Frankston website.

What rides will be at the foreshore?

Rides and Amusements are located at McCombs Reserve. Rides will stop operation at 8pm on Saturday and Sunday; ticket sales will finish 15 minutes prior to last rides each day. For a complete list of rides please visit the <u>Discover Frankston website</u>.

What performances will be at each event site? Each event site will have different performances each day. A full list of the stage programs can be found on the <u>Discover Frankston website</u>.

What COVID Safe measures will be present at this event?

In-line with our COVID Safe Plan for the event all patrons must adhere to the below terms and conditions:

- Masks must be worn in line with Chief Health Officer directives at the time of the event
- All patrons must sign in via a QR code registration upon entering a Live and Local event site
- 1.5m physical distancing must be adhered to at all times, including when waiting in queues and moving through the event sites
- If you are feeling unwell you should not attend the event and go and get tested
- If you are awaiting a test result or have been asked to self-isolate or quarantine by the Victorian Department of Health you cannot enter the event site
- Each event site will have a capacity limit, which will dictate how many people can be in that area. Please respect any directions given to you by event staff or security in the event capacity limits have been met
- There will be increased cleaning and sanitisation throughout our event sites, with a focus on high-touch points. Deep cleaning will occur between each event day
- Hand sanitiser stations will be positioned throughout the event sites
- COVID Safe marshals will be present at each location.

Can I bring my pet to these events?

As per local laws, dogs are not permitted on the beach between **9:30am** and **7:30pm**, nor are they permitted in <u>Frankston's Central Activities Area</u> (CAA). Pets are permitted in all other instances provided they are on a lead/restrained. Restrictions do not apply to service animals.

Will there be security at these events?

Yes, Victoria Police and crowd-control professionals will be monitoring the event and taking a zero-tolerance approach to unruly behaviour. Security and our COVID Marshals will be monitoring compliance with our COVID Safe measures.

Will there be changes to beach access?

No, all access to the beach and Frankston Pier will remain as per normal conditions.

What other facilities are on site?

<u>Toilets</u> – There are toilet facilities (including accessible toilet and baby change facilities) located nearby or within each event site.

<u>Drinking water</u> - The South East Water hydration station will be located at the foreshore site. There is a water bubbler located at the Frankston and Seaford Library also. Don't forget to bring your reusable bottle to refill! *Bottled water can be purchased from food vendors at all sites*.

Can I consume alcohol at these events?

No, these events are alcohol free.

Is the event smoke free?

Yes, Frankston City Council events are smoke free.

Where is it best to park my car?

There are public car parks surrounding all event sites. Please check signage for applicable fees and restrictions.

What if the weather is inclement?

In some conditions it may be necessary for aspects of these events to be modified. In extreme conditions, where it is deemed unsafe to continue, programming may be delayed or cancelled. You can keep up to date by following the Frankston Events Facebook page.

Can I take public transport to the event?

Yes, we encourage you to take public transport where possible. Head to www.ptv.vic.gov.au to plan your journey.

What carparks will be closed for the event?

The Long Island Drive carpark will be closed from 11:59pm Friday 19 March until 11:59pm Sunday 21 March 2021.

Will I be able to use the Kananook Creek boat ramp?

Yes, the Kananook Creek boat ramp will not be impacted by the event.

Are fireworks scheduled?

No there will be no fireworks at this event.
